## **The Committee Room, Town Hall, High Street, Maidstone Kent ME14 1TF**

### Directions:

(By car) From the M20, exit Junction 6 signposted Maidstone / Chatham. Follow the A229 into Maidstone. The Town Hall is located in the middle of the High Street (on the gridlines of C4 and D4 on the map slightly downhill from the Queen's Monument) and entry to the building is via the Tourist Information Centre, at the front of the building.

The High Street, Bank Street and Week Street are restricted to traffic during the day but there is disabled car parking directly outside the Town Hall in the High Street. It is no more than a 10 minutes walk from several car parks – perhaps the closest are Medway Street (grid C4 on the map) and King Street (a multi-storey car park in D4).

The nearest train station is Maidstone East, approximately a 10 minute walk down Week Street and then onto the High Street.
